Green School Bali is an award-winning international school whose mission is to empower students to take ownership of their education and become leaders in sustainability, to become "changemakers." The school combines academic rigor with experiential learning in one of the world's most unique environments - a 100% carbon-neutral campus, featuring open classrooms and sustainable bamboo architecture. The curriculum is underpinned by student-led community projects that engage with stakeholders at a local, Indonesian, and global scale, bringing out the global citizenship and environmental consciousness inherent in Green School students. Green School is accredited by WASC and Indonesian SPK, and is recognized for its leadership in sustainability education with 7 international awards, underscoring its impact locally and globally.

Curriculum:

Green School's academic year is divided into four terms, with a requirement of 27 credits for graduation. Our curriculum is designed to engage students with real-world sustainability challenges and prepare them for a rapidly changing world. Classes are offered at Foundations, Intermediate, and Advanced levels, representing the rigors and academic demands for each level. Students of all ages select courses based on requirements, interest and ability, with advisors guiding their selections. Multidisciplinary classes integrate different subjects, debate, and discourse blends analytical reasoning with critical thinking and communication skills for a well-rounded learning experience.

Green Stone Capstone:

All graduates complete the Green Stone project — a two-year project addressing an issue around sustainability. They identify the problem, create a project around it, manage the project, connect with internal and external stakeholders, undergo a rigorous defense of their findings and methods, and celebrate their stories and achievements in a TED-style talk presented to the community. This capstone process demonstrates students' learning and leadership in creating solutions for human and other-than-human communities.

Other Highlights:

Advance Placement (AP) Courses: Available in Environmental Studies, Statistics, and Pre-Calculus.

Independent Study: Students can pursue their passions with flexibility beyond the standard curriculum and receive credit inside or outside the school, provided they create a learning artifact that meets pre-established standards.
