The Smile Shop is a second hand shop (think "thrift store") located in Ubud that sells used clothes, books, toys, household goods (including plates, towels, lamps-almost anything) in order to help pay for operations for people born with cleft palate, cleft lip, or any other craniofacial disabilities. This non- profit shop has helped 1,792 people to have these life changing operations.
